This states that you understand & comply with the studio rules.

—Monthly Tuition

Tuition is due on the first lesson of each month. There are 36 weeks in the dance year, broken down to 9 equal payments, even though you may not receive 4 classes in a month.

—A \$5 late fee will be added to your account if not paid by the 10th of the month.

—An additional \$5 will be added if not paid by the 15th of the month.

—An additional \$5 will be added if not paid by the 20th of the month.

—Students will not be able to participate in classes if tuition is not paid after the 25th of the month.

Payments can be made using visa/master card, check or cash at the studio or online through our website.

Please make checks payable to SHOWTIME DANCE SCHOOL & include the student's name on the check if it is different then the parent/guardian. There is a \$25 charge on all returned checks.

—School Cancelations

If Newton Schools are cancelled or dismissed early due to the cold weather, then all classes will be cancelled.

We will send parents e-mails to confirm the cancelation and have it announced on KCOB.

Note ~ Showtime Dance School is allowed one snow day per dance class without a make-up date.

——**Waiting Area/Parents Watch Week**

Students are required to wear the appropriate dance attire to class. This includes leotards, tights, jazz pants, dance shorts & dance t-shirts. Absolutely no jeans of any kind will be permitted. Students need to pull their hair out of their face and wear the necessary shoes for each class they are in. Please have a bag to transfer their shoes in. Below are the required shoes for each age group. You may order shoes through our studio.

	3rd grade & up ~ tan slip on tap shoe	Jazz-Pom:	Pre/kind-8th grade ~ tan jazz shoe
Ballet:	All ages ~ "ballet pink" ballet shoes	Tumbling:	Bare feet
Jazz:	1st-12th grade ~ tan slip on jazz shoe	Pointe:	Shoes will be discussed on first day
Lyrical:	7th-12th grade ~ nude foot undies	Competition:	Shoes will be discusses later in the year.

1st-2nd: \$50

3rd-6th: \$55

7th-12th: \$65

Costume Deposit #1 is due: Sept 21-24. (\$20 per costume is due) - non refundable

Costume Balance is due by Oct 29th—non refundable

——**Recital Fee** A \$40 recital fee per family is due by Thursday, April 29th, 2010.— non refundable
